

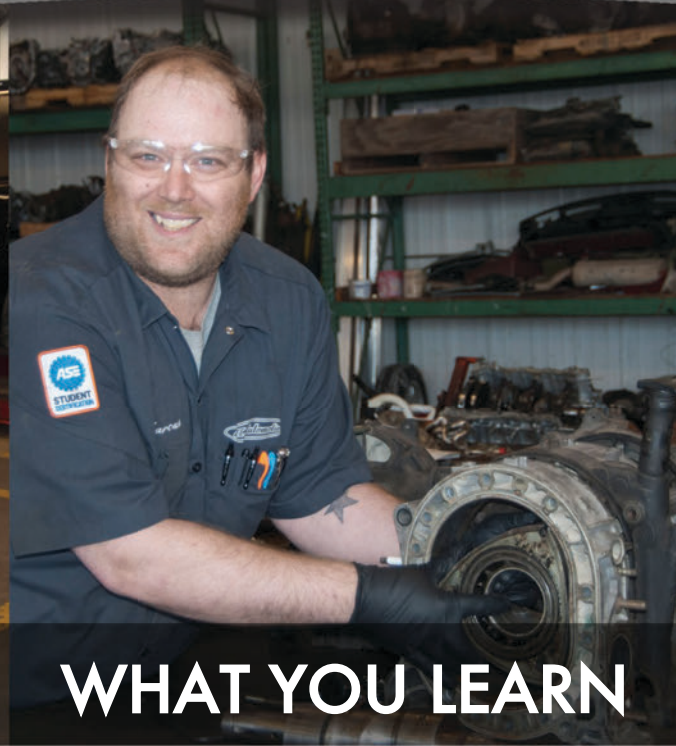


## WHAT WE DO

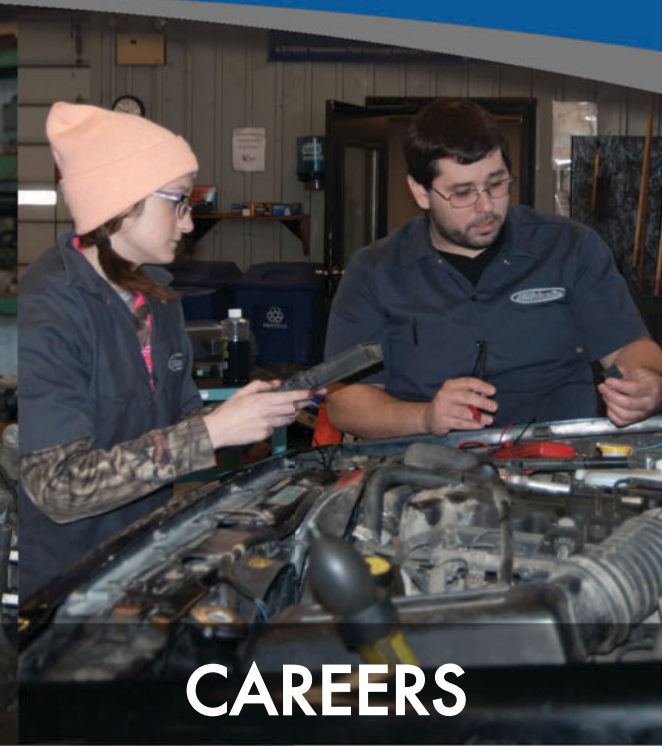
The program meets Standards for ASE Certification.



## WHAT YOU LEARN

Trouble-shooting problems are a main focus of today's technicians. While enrolled in OCC's automotive program, you will learn by hands-on training with the latest diagnostic equipment. The program assists students in increasing their automotive experience and technical aptitude. It also focuses on enhancing diagnostic, problem-solving and customer service skills while promoting a strong work ethic.

In addition to an associate's degree, the program offers Auto Service Technology I and Auto Service Technology II Certificates, which can lead to the degree. An Automotive Repair Technician Certificate is also available.



## CAREERS

After completing the program, students are qualified to work as automotive technicians at dealerships, independent garages, automotive specialty shops and parts-related businesses.

Graduates may choose to continue their education and transfer to selected senior institutions to complete a four-year degree. Advanced degrees would prepare them for employment as manufacturers' service representatives, automotive instructors and for other associated automotive management positions.

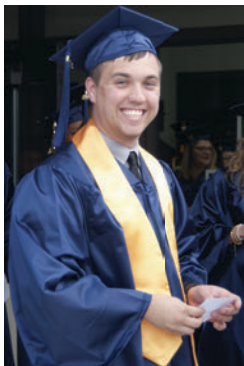
